Online applications are invited from the candidates for online admission to 1<sup>st</sup> SEM of **4-year Bachelor's degree (Honours) programme with Single Major and 3-year Bachelor's degree with Multidisciplinary programme in Humanities (B.A.) or in B.Sc. Life Science** for the Academic Session 2024-25.

### **Important points to be noted:**

(1) Online admission to U.G. Courses for the academic session 2024-25 of Government General Degree College, Narayangarh will be conducted as per the directives of the Higher Education Department, Government of West Bengal (GO No. 554-Edn(CS)/10M-95/14 Dated 21<sup>st</sup> August

2024) and CCFUP based on National Education Policy,2020 Under Vidyasagar University (w.e.f. 2023-2024) .

(2) Students will be admitted strictly on the basis of merit.

(3) No Application fee requires to be paid at the time of online application.

(4) No application will be received on any mode after the stipulated final date.

(5) The admission schedule will be intimated later through online notification. Applicants should keep a close tab on college website for further intimation in this regard.

(6) Candidates are requested to go through the entire online admission prospectus and particularly the general direction for online application carefully before filling in the form

### **Procedure of Online Application and Admission:**

1. Applicants must use their own e-mail id and personal mobile number (preferably WhatsApp No.) at the time of online application. In case the applicants do not have an e-mail id, they are requested to create an e-mail id before filling up the application form.

2. An SMS with the Application Id will be sent to each applicant after the successful submission of the application form. This application id will also be available on the filled-in and submitted application form. Candidates are requested to take this down and keep it safe.

3. All applicants should take a print out of the filled-in application form and put a signature there and keep it ready for future reference and verification of documents.

4. After the last date of submission of online application, a provisional merit list of the applicants ranked on the basis of merit will be published.

5. A window of time will be allowed for lodging any complaint to the e-mail ID: [admission@ngc.ac.in](mailto:admission@ngc.ac.in) regarding the non-inclusion of name in the provisional list or any other discrepancies there. The candidates should mention their application id and attach clear and legible images of the filled-in and submitted application form to their mails before sending them. They are also required to specifically mention the issue that they want to bring to our notice.

6. Every applicant will get a chance to apply for one 3-year Bachelor's degree with Multidisciplinary programme in Humanities and two 4-year Bachelor's degree (Honours) programmes with Single Major in Science/ Arts

7. There will be a payment gateway for paying online admission fees. The candidate will have to pay the admission fees without any fail. If any applicant enlisted in any merit list does not take admission and failed to make the e-payment within the scheduled time span, no further chance of admission can be given to him/her.

8. It is to be noted carefully that the applicants for admission are not allowed to come to the college for any enquiry or for any other purpose from the beginning to the end of the admission process.

9. Admission to all courses will be done strictly on the basis of merit as per the Govt. Order. 10. All admissions done on online system are absolutely provisional.

11. Admission will be cancelled out-right if the information stated in the applications are found not in conformity with the documents submitted at the time of verification or any fake document is produced.

12. Anti-ragging declaration as per UGC norm is to be mandatorily submitted through online by every student after admission, failing which the registration process will not be initiated.

13. Students must have ABC ID (Academic Bank of Credits) during the process of admission.

14. If any student admitted under the online system does not report for verification on the date of commencement of class or continuously remain absent for (07) seven days without any information to the college authority, his/her admission will be cancelled.

15. It is expected that the student will not book seats in more than one college at the same time.

16. In case the candidate has already been admitted to another college, the candidate must submit the hard copy of the cancellation statement/transfer certificate to the college authority on the date of verification of documents to confirm his/her admission here.

### **General direction to the applicants for Online Application and Admission**

1. Applicants are advised to make choice of the subjects wisely during application procedure. Random requests for change of subject after the initiation of admission procedure will not be entertained by the college authority.

2. Applicants are advised to avoid any typographical error. Any wrong information furnished in the application as a result of typing error may lead to the cancellation of the application. The college authority has the right to cancel any application if it is proved to be erroneous during verification.

3. Applicants must upload a passport size image, a scanned image of signature and a scanned image of H.S Marksheet at the time of submission of online application and applicants belonging to reserved categories (EWS, SC, ST, OBC-A, OBC-B, PWD etc.) must upload the scanned image of their Caste/Disability Certificates/EWS Certificates.

4. Application not accompanied by proper supporting documents will also be cancelled.

#### 5. Documents required at the time of verification:

- a) Print out of the Application Form. The candidates will have to put signatures on the specified space on the forms.
- b) Copy of Online Admission Fee payment receipt.
- c) Proof of Date of Birth (Birth Certificate/ Madhyamik or Equivalent Examination Admit Card) in original along with a self-attested photocopy of the same.
- d) Higher Secondary/equivalent Examination Mark sheet in original along with a self-attested photocopy of the same.
- e) Caste Certificate from competent authority in original along with a self-attested photocopy of the same, if applicable.
- f) Physical disability certificate from competent authority in original along with a self-attested photocopy of the same, if applicable.
- g) EWS Certificates issued by the competent authority in Government of West Bengal for the current financial year along with a self-attested photocopy of the same, if applicable.
- h) Madhyamik (10 level) mark sheet (if necessary).
- i) Print out of ABC identity number.

#### **Basic Eligibility criteria for admission to U.G. Courses:**

1. Candidate passing Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) conducted by West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent board/council are eligible for admission to both **4-year Bachelor's degree (Honours) programmes with Single Major in Science/Arts (maximum two)** and **3-year Bachelor's degree with Multidisciplinary programme in Humanities or in B.Sc. Life Science** courses within 4 (four) consecutive academic sessions from the date of passing the qualifying examination, provided that the candidate must have passed in Four (04) recognized subjects (excluding Environmental Education/ Studies) including one language subject in the qualifying examination

2. Candidate passing Higher Secondary examination (10+2) from vocational stream conducted by the respective Board/ Council for vocational studies or any equivalent board /council are eligible for admission to **3-year Bachelor's degree with Multidisciplinary programme in Humanities or in B.Sc. Life Science** courses only within 4 (four) consecutive academic session from the date of passing the qualifying examination, provided that the candidate must have passed in 4 (four) recognized subjects including at least one language subject in qualifying examination.

#### **Specific Eligibility Conditions—**

##### **1. Bachelor's degree (Honours) with (Single) Major in Arts:**

Students who have passed Higher secondary or equivalent examination with minimum 45% marks in aggregate (to be calculated by adding the marks obtained in 'Best four' subjects excluding Environmental Studies) or 50% marks in the subject or related subject (in which the

admission in major course is sought) are eligible to apply for admission in Bachelor's degree program (Honours) with Single Major.

## 2. **Bachelor's degree (Honours) with (Single) Major in Science:**

Students who have passed Higher secondary or equivalent examination with minimum 45% marks in aggregate (to be calculated by adding the marks obtained in 'Best four' subjects excluding Environmental Studies) or 50% marks in the subject (in which the admission in major course is sought) **or related subject in case of Nutrition and Microbiology** are eligible to apply for admission in Bachelor's degree program (Honours) with Single Major.

### **Bachelor's degree (Honours) in Nutrition**

Regarding admission to Bachelor's degree (Honours) in Nutrition (as single major) only those students are eligible who have passed

- **Either Nutrition with Biology or Chemistry at the H.S. level.**
- Or,
- **Both Biology (to be considered "the related subject" in place of Nutrition for eligibility) and Chemistry at the H.S. level.**

### **Bachelor's degree (Honours) in Microbiology**

Regarding admission to Bachelor's degree (Honours) in Microbiology (as single major), only those students are eligible who have passed **both Biology/Biotechnology (to be considered "the related subject" in place of Microbiology for eligibility) and Chemistry at the H.S. level.**

## 3. **Bachelor's degree with multidisciplinary programme in Humanities or B.Sc. Life Science.**

Genders Allowed: All For Category [Any] & Passing Year [2024, 2023, 2022, 2021] (Must Pass in Class 10+2 Exam and Must Pass in 4 Subjects Including Minimum one Language Subject Excluding (Environment Studies, Environmental Education) in Class 10+2 Exam)

### **Other Important Information:**

I] Candidates who have passed the qualifying examination in 2021, 2022 and 2023 may also apply.

II] Candidates who have passed 10+2 level examination from West Bengal State Council of Technical and Vocational Education and Skill Development are eligible to apply for only **3-year Bachelor's degree with Multidisciplinary programme in Humanities or B.Sc. Life Science courses.**

## Merit Point Calculation Rule

### 4-year Bachelor's degree (Honours) with (Single) Major in Science/Arts:

Merit point for admission in Bachelor's degree (Honours) with (Single) Major course to be calculated by adding 10% of total marks obtained in the Best four subjects excluding Environmental Studies and the marks obtained in the subject selected as major subject.

For Bachelor's degree (Honours) with Nutrition as Major course, in case the applicant does not have **Nutrition** as a subject in the Higher Secondary (Class 12) or equivalent examination, his/ her marks in either Biology or Chemistry (whichever is higher) in place of "the subject selected as major subject" will be considered for merit point calculation.

For Bachelor's degree (Honours) with Microbiology as Major course, as Microbiology is not present as a subject in the Higher Secondary (Class 12) or equivalent examination, his/ her marks in either Biology, Biotechnology or Chemistry (whichever is higher) in place of "the subject selected as major subject" will be considered for merit point calculation.

- The admission will be based on the marks obtained in the Higher Secondary (Class 12) or equivalent examination.
- In case of a tie, the marks of the subject (from HS) selected as major subject will be used as a final tie-breaker.
- If the tie persists, the aggregate marks of the Madhyamik (Class 10) or equivalent examination will be used as a tie-breaker.
- Again, if the tie persists, the marks of the First Language subject (from Class X Exam) will be used as a final tie-breaker.

### 3-year Bachelor's degree with multidisciplinary programme in Humanities:

Merit point for admission in Bachelor's degree with multidisciplinary programme in Humanities/B.Sc. Life Science course is to be calculated by adding the marks obtained in Best Four subjects (excluding Environment Studies) including one language subject Studies at Higher Secondary / Equivalent examination. The admission will be based on the marks obtained in the Higher Secondary (Class 12) or equivalent examination.

- In case of a tie, the marks of the subject (from HS) selected as major subject will be used as a final tie-breaker.
- If the tie persists, the aggregate marks of the Madhyamik (Class 10) or equivalent examination will be used as a tie-breaker.
- Again, if the tie persists, the marks of the First Language subject (from Class X Exam) will be used as a final tie-breaker.

## **UG programmes offered by GGDC, Narayangarh**

The College offers the following UG Programme:

### **A] Single Major programmes:**

a) 4-year Bachelor's degree (Honours) with Single Major in Arts field of studies (8 semesters with 166 credits)

b) 4-year Bachelor's degree (Honours) with Single Major in Science field of studies (8 semesters with 166 Credits)

### **B] Multidisciplinary programmes:**

c) 3-year Bachelor's degree with Multidisciplinary programme of studies in Humanities (6 semesters with 126 Credits)

d) 3-year Bachelor's degree with Multidisciplinary programme in Life Science (B. Sc.) (6 semesters with 126 Credits)

### **Type of Awards with stage of Exit (for all programmes)**

- a) UG Certificate: A UG certificate will be awarded when a student exits at the end of 1<sup>st</sup> Year. A UG certificate requires two semesters with 40 credits and Community service of 4 credits.
- b) UG Diploma: At the end of the 2nd year, if a student exits, a UG diploma shall be awarded. A diploma requires four semesters with 86 credits including Internship/Apprenticeship/project of 4 credits.
- c) Bachelor's degree: On successful completion of three years, the relevant Bachelor's degree shall be awarded. A Bachelor's degree requires six semesters with 126 credits
- d) Bachelor's degree (Honours): On the successful completion of the fourth year, a student shall be awarded a degree Honours. A Bachelor's degree Honours requires an eight semester with total of 166 credits.

### **Different disciplines/Subjects to study under CCFUP:**

**Major discipline (MJ):** Major discipline is the discipline or subject of main focus and the degree will be awarded in that discipline. Courses shall be of 4 credits.

**Minor discipline (MI):** A minor discipline to be opted from the bunch/ group of subjects assigned for the Major subject. Courses shall be of 4 credits.

**Multidisciplinary course (MDC):** A multi-disciplinary course is an option to explore disciplines of interest beyond the choices students make in major courses. Three (03) courses of 3 Credits each are common for all programmes.

**Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC):** These are generic courses aimed to enhance skills in communication and local languages.

Four (04) SEC courses shall be of 2 credits each distributed in first four semesters.

**Skills Enhancement Courses (SEC):** These courses are aimed at imparting practical skills, hands-on training, soft skills, etc., to enhance the employability of students. Three (03) SEC courses shall be of 3 credits each. Colleges shall arrange the skill training to the students in association with Sector Skill Councils (SSC)/ Paschim Banga Society for Skill Development (PBSSD) or any other recognized council/organizations. Separate list of courses under SEC may be provided in due course. Training, assignment evaluation etc. shall be conducted at the College level. SEC courses may also be taken from the SWAYAM/ MOOC/ NSQF platform as per applicability. College authority may designate course coordinator for SEC for each discipline who may guide students to complete the courses.

**Value-Added Courses (VAC):** Two (02) introductory-level Value added courses are to enhance the standard of the students beyond specified academic curriculum. Courses shall be of 2 credits each. Two (02) VACs to be selected from below:

**For Semester-I (01 paper -fixed)**

Environmental Studies (common for all programmes)

**For Semester-II (01 paper to be selected)**

Human Rights

Yoga and Wellness

Disaster Management



### **Summer Internship /Apprenticeship/Community Services:**

Students will be provided with opportunities for Internship /Apprenticeship/Community Services with nearby locality, local bodies, local industry, business organizations, health and allied areas. It shall be a short - term engagement of 8 weeks in a suitable organization or hands on training in order to gain work experience.

There shall be two forms of summer training:

**Community Services (4 Credits):** In the 1st year of study, students shall be oriented to Community Services during summer term. Minimum 45-60 hours engagement in NSS, Rural Development, Social Development activities under the supervision of College Teacher.

**Internship/ Apprenticeship (4 Credits):** In the 2nd year of study, students shall be oriented to Internship/ Apprenticeship. Minimum 8 weeks engagement in local bodies, local industry, NGOs, business organizations, health and allied areas, rural entrepreneurs, local governments (such as panchayats, municipalities), survey, media organizations, artists, crafts persons etc. shall be under the supervision of the College. After completion of internship/ Apprenticeship students will have to produce a report related to the work carried out

### **Modalities of selection of Disciplines/Subjects during Admission:**

#### **1. Bachelor's degree of 4-year programme (Honours) with Major in Science/ Arts field of studies**

- a) Major- 1 subject
- b) Minor - 2 subjects (according to Subject Bunching /Combination allowed under CCFUP)

#### **2. Bachelor's degree of 3-year programme with Multidisciplinary Studies in Humanities**

- a) Major- 2 subjects
- b) Minor -1 subject (according to Subject Bunching /Combination allowed under CCFUP)

A candidate wishing to apply for 4-year Bachelor's degree (Honours) programme with Single Major/ 3-year Bachelor's degree programme with Multidisciplinary Studies in Humanities must choose his/her Major discipline and Minor discipline from subject bunching/combination allowed under CCFUP (w.e.f. 2023-2024) directed by Vidyasagar University.

A candidate wishing to apply for 3-year Bachelor's degree programme with Multidisciplinary programme of studies in Humanities can only choose Physical Education as minor discipline from subject bunching/combination allowed under CCFUP (w.e.f. 2023-2024) directed by Vidyasagar University.
